

## Introduction

This report provides the latest key information from Devon Home Choice and covers 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

# Households registered with Devon Home Choice

The total number of households in housing need (Bands A to D) fell from 18,906 in April 2017 to 17,230 at 3 July 2017, a decrease of 5%.

As a result of renewal activity the numbers fell by 47% in South Hams, 30% in North Devon, 15% in West Devon and 7% in Torridge. There were also small reductions in East Devon, Mid Devon and Torbay.

The overall percentages of applicants in Bands D & E fell whilst the percentage in Band B increased from 20% to 21% indicating that the renewals have led to a cleansing of inactive applications in the lower bands in particular.

Note: The percentages given for Bands A – D refer to the proportion of households in housing need who are in that Band (e.g. 21% of all households in housing need across Devon are in Band B). The percentage given for Band E refers to the proportion of households in Band E of all those registered (e.g.32% of households registered across Devon are in Band E).

The greatest need across all local authority areas remains for one bedroom properties, (Table 2) with 57% of applicants requiring one bedroom. The percentages for all needs remain the same as the previous quarter.





Table 4 and Chart 3 below show the number of bids placed in each month of 2017 and the number of households who have placed at least one bid in each month. These figures will be used to measure the effects of the implementation of the email property alert function which is currently being tested and should be live by the end of August.

## Table 4: Numbers of bids and bidders by month








Table 5 shows the number of households in each Local Authority area who placed at least one bid in June 2017. The table also shows the percentage of each LAs register who bid during the month, the figures range from 14% in Torridge to 37% in Teignbridge.

Table 6 below shows the average number of bids received by property size. The figures for 1, 2 and 3 bedroom properties all fell from the previous month. However, as can be seen in Chart 4 the figures for 2 and 3 bedroom properties are higher than in the corresponding quarter of previous years.

92% of General needs homes advertised in Q1 received 10 or more bids.




Chart 4: Average number of bids received in Q1 by bedroom size




Chart 5: Average number of bids received in Q1 by bedroom size



# Homes let

The proportion of general needs homes let to applicants in Band B during the quarter increased to 52% from 45% in the previous quarter and is the second highest since Q1 in 2014/15. The figures range from 23% in South Hams to 66% in Torridge.

Over 31,600 homes have been let through Devon Home Choice since it began in 2010.


