- a connection to the Parish of Exmouth demonstrated by one or more of the following in priority order:
- being permanently resident therein for a continuous period of at least three years out of the five years immediately prior to being offered an Affordable Dwelling; or
- being formally permanently resident therein for a continuous period of five years; or
- (iii) having his or her place of permanent work (normally as regarded as 16 hours or more a week and not including seasonal employment) therein for a continuous period of at least 12 months immediately prior to being offered the Affordable Dwelling; or
- (iv) having a connection through a close family member (normally mother, father, brother, sister, son or daughter) where the family member is currently resident therein and has been so for a continuous period of at least five years immediately prior to being offered the Affordable Dwelling and whether there is independent evidence that the family member is in need of support or can give support.
 - (v) or such person as is prescribed by the Allocation of

Housing (Qualification Criteria for Right to Move) (England) Regulations 2015

and in the event that no one satisfying the above requirements can be found within the Parish of Exmouth then the process shall be repeated considering persons from the administrative area of East Devon District Council
